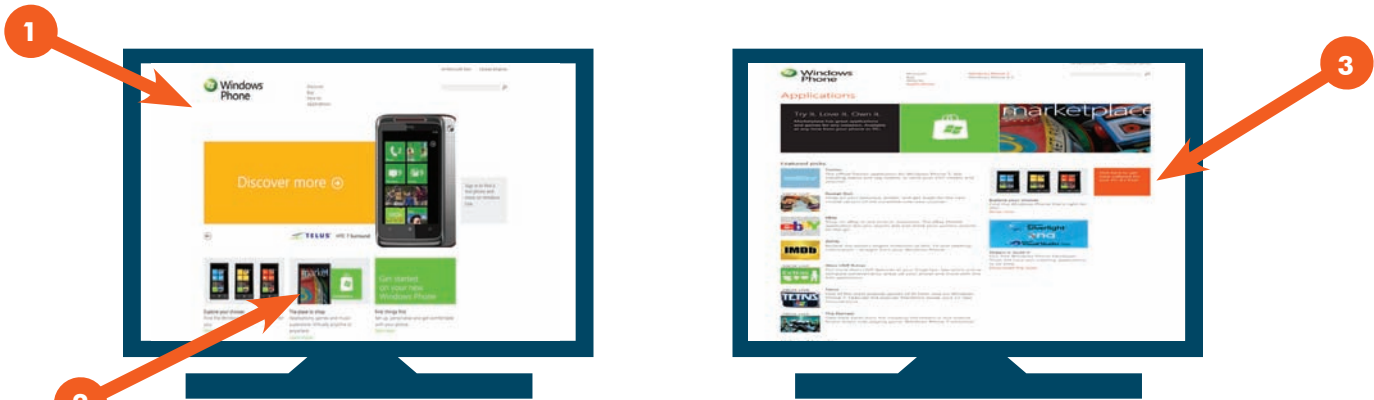
To download apps to a PC

- If a phone is connected and synched **OR** just to view Apps offered by Microsoft on your PC you need Zune software.
- Once Zune is installed and the user is logged in, the user will see the “**Marketplace**” menu at the top.
- The Win 7 phone will have the “**Marketplace**” tile thumbnail by default so the user will be able to select and start shopping for apps.

To get the Zune Software:



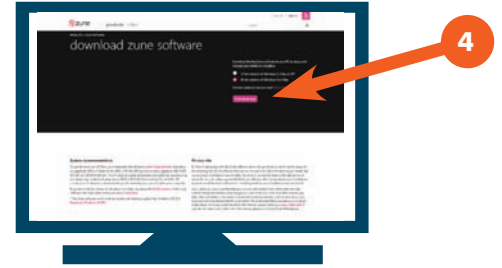

User can use phone account to login and purchase apps.



Windows Phone 7

To get to Marketplace on phone, just select the marketplace icon.

- Press **Marketplace** 
- Then press the **Search**  button (hard button on device)
- Then type in **Realtor.ca**

Alternatively:

- Select the proper menu's to find the REALTOR.ca app.
- **Tools/New** or **Tools/Free**. If you select **All/Free** it will be a longer list.
